COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT - JUNIORS

I (**INSERT COACHES FULL NAME**), hereby commit, to the best of my ability, to uphold the Beaumaris Football Club (BFC) Coaches Code of Conduct as stipulated below.

I agree to abide by the club and leagues requirement to obtain the necessary qualifications to enable me/us to coach football at the Beaumaris Football Club, and will provide the club with all necessary details. I understand that without appropriate coaching accreditation I will be unable to continue coaching.

I will obtain and carry a valid Working with Children Check as is required by the Clubs Child Safety Standards.

I will adopt an inclusive approach and respect the rights, dignity and worth of all individuals within the context of my involvement at BFC, including refraining from any discriminatory practices on the basis of gender race, religion, ethnic background or disability.

I will display and foster respect for umpires, opponents, coaches, administrators, other officials, parents and spectators.

I will refrain from any form of personal abuse or unnecessary physical contact that is not appropriate with the players in my care.

I will have due consideration for varying maturity and ability levels of my players when designing practice schedules, activities and involvement in competition.

I will stress and monitor safety and welfare always.

In recognising the significance of injury and sickness, I will follow physician's advice concerning the return of injured or ill players.

I will endeavour to keep informed regarding sound principles of coaching and skill development, and of factors relating to the welfare of my players.
