



## Beaumaris Football Club (Juniors) Playing Policy

(Updated August 2024.)

### Under 8 – Under 10

- No limit on players to be available per game throughout the home and away rounds.
  - The club will endeavour to organise teams with a minimum number of players to ensure more game time e.g. 18-20.
- A roster system may be used if the team has more than 24 registered players.
- If a team has 24 players, every endeavour is made for each player to play three (3) quarters per game during the home and away series and the Lightning Carnival matches.
- Where the team has less than 24 players, the opportunity to play 4 quarters should be spread evenly throughout the group over the season.
  - The Coach can monitor attendance at training, attitude at training, general behaviour and a willingness to listen and learn as an incentive for more or less game time.
- It is expected that over a period of two to three weeks players will have been rotated through the back line, midfield and forward line.

### Under 11 – Under 13

- Home and Away Games:
  - No limit on players to be available per game throughout the home and away rounds.
  - A roster system may be used, at the coaches' discretion, if the team has more than 24 registered players.
  - If a team has 24 players or less, every endeavour is made for each player to play at least three (3) quarters per game during the home and away series.
  - Where the team has less than 24 players, the opportunity to play 4 quarters should be spread evenly throughout the group over the season.
    - The Coach can monitor attendance at training, attitude at training, general behaviour and a willingness to listen and learn as an incentive for more or less game time.

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- For Finals Games:
  - Every player who has qualified, and has had a reasonable training attendance record will be selected to play. Unlimited players can be utilised for finals.
  - In finals, every endeavour will be made to ensure that each player has at least two (2) quarters of football.
  - The Coach can monitor attendance at training, attitude at training, general behaviour and a willingness to listen and learn as an incentive for more or less game time.
  - The coach has the authority to use their discretion if in their opinion a player's physical capabilities restricts a player from playing in certain positions.

## Under 14 – Under 18

- Home and away Series:
  - No limit on players to be available per game throughout the home and away rounds.
  - A roster system may be used, at the coaches' discretion, if the team has more than 24 registered players.
  - Every endeavour is made for each player to play at least two (2) quarters of football per game.
    - The Coach can monitor attendance at training, attitude at training, general behaviour and a willingness to listen and learn as an incentive for more or less game time.
- Finals Series:
  - Every player who has qualified and has had a reasonable training attendance record can be selected to play. Unlimited players can be utilised for finals.
  - It is at the Coaches discretion to have more than 24 players playing on the day,
  - In finals, every endeavour is made to ensure that each player plays at least one (1) quarter of football.
  - The coach has the authority to use their discretion if in their opinion a player's physical capabilities restricts the player from playing in certain positions.
